**Candidacy statements must be received by May 15th.** Please limit your description to about 200 words. Submissions by email are preferred. If you have any questions about serving on the Board or about your eligibility, please contact a current Board member.

The entire chapter membership will be sent the ballot, which will include the names and statements of the candidates.

The three- and one-year positions will be filled in order of the number of votes received. The three candidates that receive the largest number of votes will fill the three-year position, and the candidate receiving the 4th largest number of votes will fill the one-year position. Once the new Board is elected, it will elect the officers at the July Board meeting, which will be held on Saturday July 20, 2002, in the Lake Tahoe area.

We need everyone's support and participation to make this a viable organization, so please consider running for a Board position. There are many ways you can give back to the industry, but none as valuable as helping join erosion control professionals in a pursuit of shared knowledge and experience. And besides, it is fun too.
